



THE STORY

Following more than 30 years adapting farming practices to the mountain climate and terrain around the winery, we are pleased to produce this wine from several vineyard blocks yielding fruit of mature character and balance. The heart of this wine is Cabernet Sauvignon grown on steep, west facing terraces that rise above the early renowned Wedding Vineyard, reaching a towering elevation of 1,400 feet. Other contiguous vineyard blocks incorporate a great diversity of soils and exposures, providing additional complexity and unmistakable mountain terroir.

THE WINE

- 85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Cabernet Franc, 7% Merlot
- Aged 20 months in French oak (80% new)
- Alcohol by volume 14.7%
- Bottle date: June 2012
- 350 cases produced

TASTING NOTES

Fisher's 2010 Cabernet Sauvignon Mountain Estate Vineyard is a bit bigger and richer than the Wedding, with a little less in the way of structure. A big, boisterous wine, the 2010 is literally bursting with fruit. Blueberries, blackberries, savory herbs, tobacco, smoke and licorice all flow through to the inviting, caressing finish. There is considerable early and medium-term appeal in this rich, fruit-driven Cabernet-based red. In 2010, the blend is 86% Cabernet Sauvignon and 7% Malbec, with dollops of Cabernet Franc and Merlot.
