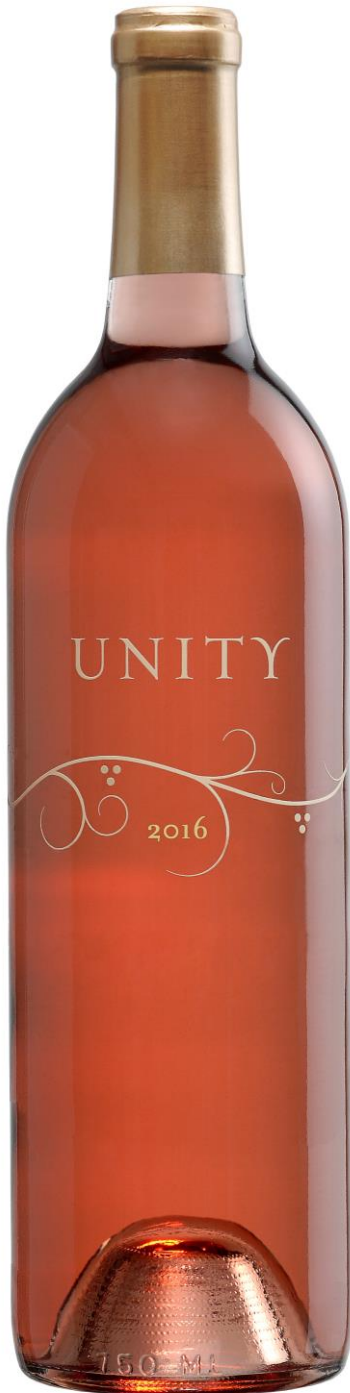

Cold settled in tank, racked to barrel

Fermented dry in neutral thick-staved barrels

100% French oak barrels

Racked off lees following primary fermentation

No malolactic fermentation
